David Nissenberg is a San Diego attorney who is the author of *The Law of Commercial Trucking: Damages to Persons and Property* (3d. ed.) published by LexisNexis. His two-volume treatise with two current supplements per year runs over 1000 pages and has been referred to as the "bible" on commercial trucking law and mandatory for any attorney involved in truck accident litigation. It is widely used in this country by both the plaintiff and defense bar.

Mr. Nissenberg started his career as an attorney with the Federal Maritime Commission and after a stint as a prosecutor in Dade County, Florida he spent a year with a Washington, D.C. law firm working on legal matters affecting SEALAND, the original ocean container company and McLean Trucking whose owner created the containership mode of transportation.

Mr. Nissenberg's four-hour CLE seminar, "Truck Accident Litigation in a Nutshell" was presented over 300 times in 125 cities throughout the United States from 1996 to 2007.

Mr. Nissenberg currently works out of his office in La Jolla, California as a consultant to plaintiff's attorneys on all matters involving truck accident litigation and the FMCSRs. His theories on ocean carrier liability have helped many attorneys find insurance coverage in container-related accidents where none was thought to exist.
