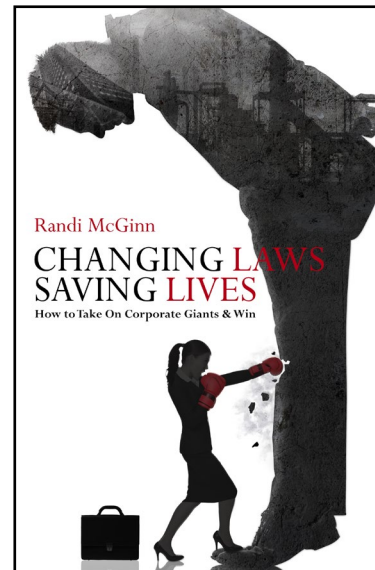

She is one of the country’s leading trial lawyers, having tried over 130 cases – everything from workplace violence to medical malpractice to products liability lawsuits. The first woman president of the Inner Circle (100 best trial lawyers in the US), she is known for her creativity in the courtroom and use of demonstrative evidence to visualize opening, direct, cross-examination and closing argument. She has destroyed adverse witnesses by leaving a pretentious Beverly Hills doctor standing in front of the jury covered with post-its and clutching a grapefruit to his chest, by grilling a government snitch until he threw up and by exposing the fact that a world-renowned polygraph expert had been polygraphing his own sperm cells in the dead of night. In a particularly hard won police shooting case, the local SWAT cops once put her face on their Christmas pinata and took turns whacking it with a big stick.



She recently was appointed as a special prosecutor and tried the first murder prosecution of an Albuquerque police officer for an on the job shooting. In 2019 obtained the largest verdict ever against a semi trailer manufacturer for its decision not to build its trailers with side underride guards which would prevent passenger cars from becoming trapped underneath semis.

Started her career by giving birth to daughter Heather, now age 39, the day before the 3 day bar examination.
